Year 1	Regular plural noun suffixes, suffixes that can be added to verbs where no change is needed, how the prefix un- changes the meaning of verbs and adjectives, how words can combine to make sentences, joining words and joining clauses using and, sequencing sentences to form short narratives, separation of words with spaces, introduction to capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences, capital letters for names and for the personal pronoun.		
Year 2	Formation of nouns using suffixes, formation of adjectives using suffixes, use of suffixes –er –est in adjectives and the use of –ly in		

	standard English to turn adjectives into adverbs, subordination and co-ordination, expanded noun phrases, how the grammatical patterns in a sentence indicate its function as a statement, question, exclamation or command, correct use of present tense and past tense, use of the progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense to mark actions in progress, use of capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences, commas in a list, apostrophes to mark where letters are missing in spelling and to mark singular possession in nouns.
